$2/11, 1/11, 11/11, 4/11, 8/11$



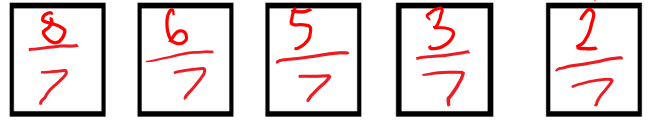
5) Write these fractions from largest to smallest.

$5/5, 4/5, 6/5, 3/5, 2/5$



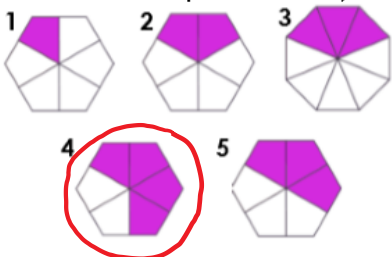
6) Write these fractions from largest to smallest.
