




## Evenwood C of E Primary School Proposed Sport Premium Spending 2020-21



In the 2020/21 academic year we expect to receive £16,650. Plus, the additional money from the academic year 2019-20 (£3361). The total monies available for this academic year is £20,011. The money will be spent to fulfil the following grant conditions:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity.
2. The profile of PE and sport raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increasing participation in competitive sport.

Staindrop Sport Partnership	<p>To provide opportunities for all pupils to access competitive sport. Every child will attend a competition or festival and will compete against other children from local schools. Competitions include: tag rugby, hockey, football, cricket, netball and many more.</p> <p>All children will attend sport festivals. Level 2 apprentice	The apprentice's role is to support the teaching of P.E across the school. They will support students who are currently not meeting age expected targets and will challenge the gifted and talented pupils within and outside of lessons. The apprentice will run lunch time clubs including a Change 4 Life club with members of staff to engage all pupils in a variety of different sports, this will also help to further increase the profile of sport across the school. The apprentice will work with the subject leader to integrate new members into the already established sports organising crew to aid the development and running of Intra-school competitions. School PE Kit	Purchasing school PE kit throughout the school will allow all of the children to regularly participate in sports and PE. It will allow all children to take part in a number of different sporting activities they would not be able to without the kit.	1,2,3,5	£100
