

**Creative (Art, DT)**  
**Design and Technology**  
Cooking and Nutrition

Together we will be looking at the principles of a healthy diet and where food comes from. Children will link their knowledge now by discussing the difference between how we get food now compared to WW1. Children will be cooking a range of different foods using WW1 recipes.

Fabric  
Your child will be using a range of materials and equipment to make medals from WW1.

Making Models of Tanks and Trenches  
Your child will be researching tanks and trenches before designing their own using a range of equipment and materials.

**Art and Design**  
Your child will be using a range of equipment and materials to create WW1 art. Children will be creating their own poppy mobiles, clay poppies and mosaic artwork. Children will also be looking at the artwork by Andy Goldsworthy

**PE**  
Run the Loop - Your child will be developing their batting and fielding skills with this group game. They will continue to work on their hand eye coordination, throwing and catching in games scenarios.

**Computing**  
This term, your child will be improving their mouse skills. They will look at programming toys, such as remote control cars and beebots to enable them to travel to a desired location.

**Humanities (History, Geography)**  
**History**  
In history, your child will be looking closely at key historical figures from WW1. Children will be researching Edith Cavell and Walter Tull.

**Geography**  
Your child will be developing their map skills by using a range of maps, atlases and globes to find the United Kingdom. Children will be creating maps with and without keys and using their maps around the school grounds. Children will build on their knowledge of countries, continents and oceans.

**Music**  
This term, we will be looking at 80's hip-hop style music. We will be developing our knowledge of the pulse of music and learning how to play rhythms and beats with musical instruments with music.

# World War 1

**English**  
This term, your child will be looking to improve their punctuation and sentence structure. We will explore a range of different sentence types. We will be looking at a range of text types, including narratives, recounts and poetry.

**Basic Skills**  
Your child will be exploring simple sentences and the basic punctuation used to correctly write sentences. They will look at extending their sentences using 'and'.

**Reading**  
We will be reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl as our class book. Throughout the term your child will develop their comprehension skills, by answering questions, retrieving pieces of information and sequencing events.

**Science**  
**Plants**  
Your child will be categorising plants and developing their knowledge further to identify and name common wild and garden plants. Your child will also be looking at the structure of a plant.

**RE**  
This term your child will be looking at the bible and why it is special to Christians. Children will be visiting St Pauls Church to find out more.

**Maths**  
**Mental**  
We will be developing fluency in counting forwards and backwards from zero and any given number. Your child will be doubling and halving numbers and counting in 10s.

**Main**  
This term, your child will be working on developing their place value skills which will be used to solve addition and subtraction problems. Your child will be using a range of concrete objects and visual representations to support them.

**Special Events**  
This term, we will be celebrating Roald Dahl day by dressing up like our favourite character. We will be raising money for McMillan Cancer Support by hosting a coffee morning and celebrating our European day of languages by singing European songs in a different language. We will also be visiting the Church which links to our RE topic.
