2) Green Tree Award.	<p>Mrs Gill discussed what the Green Tree Award was and ran through some of the activities we needed to do to gain points towards reaching the first award of bronze. The children decided to concentrate on two activities first, tree dressing and recycling. It was decided that Barnard Castle class would look at tree dressing, the history behind it and carrying out a tree dressing ceremony. Ina suggested that the whole school needed to get behind the recycling part of the award as it is something that everyone should be aware of and do more. The children discussed bins within school and talked about them not being identified as recycling bins and what should be placed in them. Isabella suggested that we organise a litter pick in school and then when we are able to we could do another litter pick around the village.</p> <p><i>Actions:</i> Ina and Ava to write to DCC to see if they can provide recycling bins for the playground.</p> <p>Harvey and Alfie to write to Mrs Rand to provide new bins for classrooms to separate recycling from general waste and to look into a designated battery bin.</p> <p>Mrs Gill and Miss Nimmo to look into a bin for food waste that we can make into compost for the school allotment.</p> <p>Bethan and Matilda to make recycling posters for the bins.</p>

	<p>3) Holocaust.</p>	<p>Miss Nimmo and Mrs Gill spoke briefly about what holocaust is. 	<p>4) Any other business.</p>	<p>Ina said some children from Durham Castle Class have spoken about a lunchtime gardening club to keep the allotment area tidy and grow produce to give to families in the village. Ava and Ina also spoke about getting some spring flowers and replanting the planters around the school.</p> <p>Action: Speak to Mrs Stevens about what is already planted in the allotment area and what needs to be done.
