In the 2022/23 academic year we expect to receive £16,830. The money will be spent to fulfil the following grant conditions:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity.
2. The profile of PE and sport raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increasing participation in competitive sport.

Staindrop Sport Partnership	To provide opportunities for all pupils to access competitive sport. Every child will attend a competition or festival and will compete against other children from local schools. Competitions include: tag rugby, hockey, football, cricket, netball and many more. All children with attend sport festivals. During the festivals children will participate in a range of activities.	4, 5 2, 3	£2750
School PE Kit	Purchasing school PE kit throughout the school will allow all of the children to regularly participate in sports and PE. It will allow all children to take part in a number of different sporting activities they would not be able to without the kit.	1, 2, 3, 5	£100

Throughout the year, all children will be involved in forest schools with an aim to broaden the range of activities and participation. This will also provide new opportunities for further after school clubs, ran by qualified staff.		
Education Enterprise	Working with education enterprise gives the school the opportunity and children opportunity to take part in new events they have not experienced before. It will offer after school and lunchtime clubs to engage children in new sports. In addition, it will upskill staff through its CPD offer.	1, 2, 3, 4, 5	£2615
Forest schools' resources	In addition to training staff on forest schools, we will purchase forest school resources. PE Resources	Purchasing new PE resources increase the school's opportunity to engage more children in new sports as well as existing sports within school.
